Fairview HOA Phase 1 - March 2020 Community Letter

Hello Neighbors -

This letter is information from the HOA Board meeting on Thursday evening, March 19, 2020.

<u>2020-21 Annual Assessment</u> – the Board voted unanimously to suspend the 2020-21 Annual Assessment, meaning that the next regular Annual Assessment will be in the Spring of 2021. Our HOA finances are in good shape to cover average expenses for this next year, and considering the COVID-19 crisis, we felt that all of us could use the money for other expenses. If a large, unexpected expense occurs, then we may need to levy a Special Assessment (CC&R Article VIII, section 4). If you have already sent your check, then it will be properly disposed of.

<u>HOA Board of Directors</u> – the current restrictions on gatherings prevent scheduling a special meeting of Owners for the purpose of Board elections. Therefore, the Board acted under section 5.2(3) of the Bylaws to approve one-year appointments of new Directors until an Owners meeting can be held. Below is the list of the current Board, followed by their positions and the length of their terms.

- Brian Sonnier Director-at-Large (2019-2021)
- Jeff Dennerline Secretary & Treasurer (2019-2021)
- Jennifer Swangle Director at Large (appointed for 2020-2021)
- Terry Hill Vice-President (2019-2021)
- Wayne Palmiter President (appointed for 2020-2021)

<u>HOA Meetings</u> – the Board set its regular meeting schedule for these Monday evenings: June 8, 2020; September 14, 2020; December 14, 2020; March 8, 2021. All owners are welcome to attend. The time and location will be communicated prior to each meeting.

<u>CC&R Review Committee</u> (Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Fairview Village HOA, Phase 1) – Wayne Palmiter is the coordinator of this group. Several owners expressed a willingness to be part of this group, and there is room for more to join. The project will kick-off in a couple of months, but we need to know now who is interested, so we can begin communicating plans. <u>ARB Committee</u> (Architectural Review Board) – Anita Perron is the coordinator of this standing committee. Several owners indicated interest in supporting the neighborhood in this way, and more participants are always welcome.
