<u>HOA Board Meeting</u> – the Board met Monday evening, November 28, 2022, at the Fairview Library (meeting notice sent to Owners via email on November 25, 2022). The next meeting date will be in mid-January 2023.

- Certification of Non-Discriminatory language to comply with Oregon HB 2534, the following statement was approved:
 The Fairview Village HOA, Phase I, certifies that its documents do not discriminate against race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, marital status, familial status, source of income, disability or the number of individuals, including family members, persons of close affinity or unrelated persons, who are simultaneously occupying a dwelling unit within occupancy limits.
- 2022 Annual Assessments the final unpaid assessment is on its way to a resolution.
- CC&R Proposed Changes the proposed changes and the procedures necessary to present them for a vote will be a topic at the next Board meeting.

<u>Wall</u> – clearing of vegetation from the HOA perimeter walls has been completed. Chris Birch and Rich Bowen are the volunteers who monitor and maintain the condition of the wall. Contact Chris at *birch98@frontier.com* to report concerns regarding wall condition.

<u>Welcome</u> – Arnetta Shaffer and Dixie Bowen are the volunteers serving on this committee, and they follow up with new owners with an HOA welcome letter and information about the HOA.
